This internal reprogramming action transfers funding from the Army National Guard to the Army Reserve for proper program execution. The realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.



Explanation: In FY 2001, the Congress added \$7.5 million for the Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) Implementation Plan in the Operation and Maintenance (O&M), Army National Guard appropriation. Of this amount, \$.350 million was intended to provide support to Army Reserve medical and chemical units for WMD initiatives; to pay for supplies, maintenance, and repairs for equipment; contractor support for unique maintenance of unit equipment; travel and support costs for collective training exercises for Reserve personnel; and to pay for instructor fees and course costs for required training. This action therefore transfers the funds to the O&M, Army Reserve appropriation for proper program execution.
