

Explanation: In FY 2001, the Congress added \$14.5 million for Hawaii Federal Health Network and Automated Clinical Practice Guidelines to the Operation and Maintenance (O&M) budget activity of the Defense Health Program (DHP) appropriation. However, the O&M budget activity is the wrong activity to execute \$13.969 million of this funding. Also, \$0.300 million was appropriated in FY 2001 to the DHP Procurement budget activity for Information Management/Information Technology Development projects for the Military Health System. This effort, however, is properly funded in the RDT&E budget activity. Additionally, \$100.0 million was appropriated to the DHP O&M budget activity in FY 2001 for Advances in Medical Practice. Within this program, a requirement has been approved by the Department to procure \$0.820 million in equipment for Photorefractive Keratectomy that requires execution in the Procurement budget activity.

This reprogramming action transfers funds to the appropriate budget activities for execution. The amounts transferred reflect the rescission levied in section 1403 of Public Law 106-554.
