

This reprogramming action transfers \$23.586 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 03/03, appropriation to various Components' appropriations for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, consistent with the provisions of Public Law 107-248, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2003. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities provided by that Act. Realignment of funds between counterdrug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Counternarcotics (CN).
