This reprogramming action transfers \$25.543 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 03/03, appropriation to Military Construction, Defense-Wide, 03/07, appropriation to meet urgent requirements for Operation Iraqi Freedom and the Global War on Terrorism. The transfer authority is pursuant to section 1901 of Public Law 108-11, the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.


