
This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to 8005 of Public Law 107-248, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2003, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-314, the Bob Stump National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2003. This action transfers \$27.0 million from Reserve Personnel, Air Force, 03/03, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 03/03, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items such as Global War on Terrorism (GWOT), based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.

Explanation: Funds are required to cover emergent critical mission readiness requirements, significant emergent fact-of-life cost increases, and GWOT costs that cannot be absorbed without severely degrading readiness. The additional funding will support repair of KC-135 aircraft damaged in theater and purchase of aircraft battle damage repair trailers, aircraft shelters, explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) protective and individual equipment, medical supplies, and spare parts. In addition, the funding will pay for long haul communication trunks and continuing 24/7 operations supporting deployed U.S. forces.
