Explanation: Funds are transferred to finance counter-terrorism military training activities for foreign governments in connection with the global war on terrorism. The Department plans to provide equipment, supplies, and services for counter-terrorism efforts in Jordan (\$3.0 million), Uzbekistan (\$1.0 million), Panama (\$.2 million), El Salvador (\$.2 million), and Paraguay (\$.1 million).
