Explanation: This item is a congressional special interest item. The University of Delaware is building a state-owned replacement vessel for the Cape Henlopen. The Henlopen and its replacement are University National Oceanographic Laboratory System (UNOLS) research vessels. In FY 2004, Congress added \$2.0 million to fund quiet operation enhancements (noise reduction) dynamic positioning capability and power systems hardware integration aboard the replacement vessel. This action realigns the funds, adjusted for congressional undistributed reductions, to the Navy's Defense Research Sciences program element. This program funds UNOLS-related costs and will allow the department to award funds as an assistance document under the auspices of an Office of Naval Research administered Broad Agency Announcement.
