

This action reprograms \$8.866 million to the correct appropriations and line items for proper execution. Specifically, this reprogramming action transfers \$5.678 million between various Defense appropriations and realigns \$0.996 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Army appropriation and \$2.192 million within the Other Procurement, Army appropriation. This action uses \$5.678 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.

Explanation: In the FY 2005 DoD Appropriations Act, the Congress provided funds for Mobi-Mat Helipad System, AN/ARS-6 Personnel Locator, Kevlar Helmet Retrofit Suspension System, and Heli-Basket Module. The funds were placed in the incorrect appropriations. This action realigns the funds to the correct appropriation and budget lines for proper execution.
