This reprogramming action is submitted in three parts. **Part I** realigns \$7.689 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation. **Part II** transfers \$4.750 million from the Procurement, Marine Corps, 05/07, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Marine Corps, 05/05, appropriation for proper execution. **Part III** transfers \$2.6 million from Other Procurement, Navy, 05/07, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 05/05, appropriation for proper execution. **Parts II and III** uses \$7.350 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005 and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress.
