

Explanation: Funds provide for the procurement of 3,500 additional Warlock-Blue jammers to meet the urgent requirement of 10,000 jammers to support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission. The Congress provided \$10 million in the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Tsunami Relief, 2005, (Public Law 109-13) to initiate Warlock-Blue procurement.
