This reprogramming action transfers \$55.5 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/06, appropriation to the Other Procurement Army, 05/07, appropriation (\$3.0 million), the Procurement of Weapons and Tracked Combat Vehicles, Army, 05/07, appropriation (\$17.0 million) and the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 05/05 appropriation (\$35.5 million) for proper execution. This transfer is in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005.


Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 05/05 **+35,500**

Explanation: The funds provide for the contracting of 200 bilingual Iraqis to serve as subject matter experts and cultural advisors to units of the Civil Affairs Command (CAC) of the Multi-National Force-Iraq on CAC reconstruction and democratization projects.
