To support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission, this reprogramming action transfers \$48.4 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/06, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation (\$8.7 million) and the Other Procurement Army, 05/07, appropriation (\$39.7 million) for execution. This transfer is in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005.

Explanation: Funds will be used to procure two fixed and six mobile Eagle Eye electronic surveillance systems for use at Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) sites in Iraq. These units will provide surveillance and security for UXO clearance teams and prevent pilferage of munitions potentially used as IEDs.
