

This reprogramming action transfers \$1.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 05/06, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2005. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
