
To support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission, this reprogramming action transfers \$139.5 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/06, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army 05/05 (\$6.2 million), appropriation, the Other Procurement Army, 05/07, appropriation (\$103.3 million), and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 05/06, appropriation (\$30.0 million). The action establishes new line items in the Other Procurement, Army 05/07, and Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 05/06 appropriations specifically for Joint IED Defeat efforts managed by the Joint IED Defeat Task Force. These efforts support urgent, real-time, warfighting needs. This transfer is in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005.

Explanation: Funds will be used to procure and field existing and promising solutions to defeat improvised explosive devices (IEDs). These solutions will involve a wide range of equipment to address an evolving and ever-changing threat. The equipment may include electronic countermeasures (ECM) equipment, radars, x-ray equipment, explosive ordnance disposal equipment, robots, surveillance equipment, physical security equipment, armored vehicles, and body and vehicle armor. Equipment procurement will benefit all deployed forces in theater, regardless of which service may ultimately retain the equipment in inventory. This is a new start line item.
