This reprogramming action is submitted in two parts. **Part I** transfers \$1.7 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Air National Guard, 05/05, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army National Guard, 05/05, appropriation. **Part II** transfers \$1.5 million from the Other Procurement, Air Force, 05/07, appropriation to the National Guard Reserve Equipment, Defense, 05/07, appropriation. These actions use \$3.2 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
