Explanation: Additional funds are needed to meet increased requirements supporting the operations in Iraq and Afghanistan. Specifically, these funds will be required for continental U.S.-based support to deploying and redeploying units and the ongoing security concerns that have significantly increased the costs associated with all Global War on Terrorism (GWOT) contracts in theater, including linguists. High operating tempo for supporting Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom has also increased logistical requirements, including contractor support for equipment, including supplies and repair parts needed to maintain Stryker vehicles.
