This action transfers \$107.0 million from the Military Personnel, Army, 05/05, appropriation and \$62.0 million from the Military Personnel, Marine Corps, 05/05, appropriation to the Military Personnel, Army, 05/06, appropriation and Military Personnel, Marine Corps, 05/06, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses special transfer authority pursuant to section 1001 of Public Law 109-13, the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Tsunami Relief Act, 2005. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.
