This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it transfers \$4.2 million from Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation (\$1.4 million); Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 05/05, appropriation (\$1.4 million); and Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 05/05, appropriation (\$1.4 million) to Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 05/05, appropriation. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005 and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action reprograms funding in support of a higher priority item, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.

Explanation: This reprogramming transfers funds for the Defense Safety Oversight Council (DSOC). The DSOC was created by the Secretary of Defense to work towards a goal of reducing workplace mishaps by 50 percent. The funds are made available from the savings generated by reemploying 200 Department-wide employees per year from the injury compensation rolls. The funding will provide for the Defense Human Resources Agency (DHRA) to centrally administer the DoD Pipeline Reemployment program.
