This action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005. This action transfers \$1.8 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 05/06, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 05/05, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.


