
This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005. This action transfers \$155.0 million from the Defense Working Capital Fund, Air Force appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated, and is determined to be in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
