This transfer is in accordance with provisions in the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2006 (Division A of Public Law 109-148).

Explanation: Funds will be used to quickly develop and adapt existing technology into man-portable equipment to conduct biometrics data collection and enrollment to: Integrate improved rapid ten-print capability to support faster and easier enrollment (\$4.6 million); Integrate new ManPortable devices for enrollment/verification devices from the Biometrics Management Office, checkpoint and other tactical operations (\$4.8 million); Accelerate Automatic Biometric Identification System (ABIS) enhancements including transaction management and Multi-Modality for data sharing (\$8.6 million); Integrate, ruggedize simplified and smaller collection and verification systems (\$1.2 million); Eliminate infrastructure gaps (\$3.2 million).
