These funds were initially transferred from the IFF to the Other Procurement, Army, 06/08, appropriation in reprogramming action FY 06-02 IR. These funds should have been transferred to the Aircraft Procurement, Army, 06/08, appropriation. This transfer is in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005.


Explanation: These funds are being reprogrammed to support the Department’s urgent need for counter-Improvised Explosive Devices equipment for theater-deployed aircraft.
