This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses special transfer authority pursuant to section 9003 in Title IX of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD), Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006, and exceeds thresholds. This action transfers \$155.0 million from the Procurement, Marine Corps, 06/08, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 06/06, appropriation (\$37.5 million); Other Procurement, Army, 06/08, appropriation (\$37.5 million); and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07, appropriation (\$80.0 million) to support the IED Defeat mission. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

Equipment procurement will benefit all deployed forces in theater, regardless of which service may ultimately retain the equipment in inventory.
