This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses special transfer authority pursuant to section 1201 of Public Law 109-234, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery. This reprogramming action transfers \$400.0 million from the Joint Improvised Explosive Device Defeat Fund, (JIEDDF), 06/08, appropriation to the Aircraft Procurement, Army, 06/08; Other Procurement, Army, 06/08; Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07; Aircraft Procurement, Navy, 06/08; Procurement, Marine Cops, 06/08; and Other Procurement, Air Force, 06/08, appropriations to restore the funding to the programs whose funds were “borrowed” to finance the critical Improvised Explosive Defeat (IED) mission (FY 06-07 PA) until the Congress enacted the FY 2006 Supplemental Appropriations Act (Public Law 109-234). This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which the funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress.
