This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006. This action transfers funding from the Other Procurement, Army, 06/08, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07, appropriation to prevent “stop work” on the Manned Ground Vehicles (MGV) project. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
