This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because these actions exceed established reprogramming thresholds and it involves items of special interest. This reprogramming action realigns \$13.4 million within Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07, appropriation to establish a new program element for the Modularity Brigade Enhancement program and provide funds to support additional development for the Advanced Precision Kill Weapon System program. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has previously been denied by the Congress.


