

To transfer \$6.5 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 07/08, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 07/08, appropriation. This supports real-time, Joint Urgent Operational Needs (JUON) and Immediate Warfighter Needs (IWN). This transfer is in accordance with provisions in the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007 (Division A of Public Law 109-289).

Explanation: These funds are being made available to the Department of the Navy to acquire Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) for Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) teams in Iraq. The UAS systems include 10 Vertical Takeoff and Landing (VTOL) systems and 3 fixed-wing systems to be used for in-theater assessment, which could lead to a viable Joint Urgent Operational Need (JUON) solution.
