

Explanation: Armored Ambulances are an Immediate Warfighter Need as outlined in the related U.S. Central Command Joint Urgent Operational Need (JUON CC-0157). These vehicles have Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) characteristics and are already funded and being procured. These funds, being made available to the U.S. Marine Corps, are to integrate medical peculiar casualty life support equipment on eight Heavy Armored Ground Ambulances to be used outside the forward operating base perimeters in Iraq and Afghanistan.
