To transfer \$49.5 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 07/08, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Army, 07/07, appropriation and Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 07/07, appropriation. This supports real-time, Joint Urgent Operational Needs (JUON) that the Joint Rapid Acquisition Cell designated as Immediate Warfighter Needs (IWN). This transfer is in accordance with provisions in the Supplemental Appropriations Act for U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public Law 110-28).

Explanation: Provides for Social Science Field Research using nine (9) Human Terrain Teams (HTTs) and two (2) Human Terrain Analysis Team (HTAT) in support of OIF, as outlined in the Joint Staff-validated, U.S. Central Command Joint Urgent Operational Need (JUON) CC-0197. This JUON has been designated an Immediate Warfighter Need. The funds provide for nine (9) HTTs (\$2.0 million each); two (2) HTAT Division-level team (\$3.0 million each), plus training for these teams and others supporting the teams (\$2.0 million); the required social science support efforts (\$10.1 million); team laptops, reach-back and logistics support (\$4.9 million). The Social Science Field Research Teams collect empirically valid information about physical and economic security, ideology & belief systems, individuals in authority and organizations to identify key determinants of group behavior. The research incorporates the fusion of data, using social science tools, from surveys, focus groups, interviews, ethnography and deployed U.S. Service members.
