**Part II** transfers \$2.6 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 07/07, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 07/07, appropriation, consistent with the provisions of Title VI of Public Law 109-289. Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Counternarcotics (CN).


