
This internal reprogramming action transfers \$1.5 million from the Defense Health Program, (DHP) Operation and Maintenance, 07/07, appropriation to the DHP, Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, 07/08, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses \$1.5 million of special transfer authority provided in section 1302 of Public Law 109-28, the United States Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress.
