This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions reprogram funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

Part I of this reprogramming action realigns \$5.3 million within the Procurement, Defense-Wide, 06/08, appropriation to procure critical flares for the rotary wing platforms using excess funding for the MH-47 Infrared Exhaust Suppressors (IES). This is a congressional special interest item.

Part II uses reimbursements from the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) transactions to procure replacement High Mobility Multi-Purposed Wheeled Vehicles (HMMWV) to fill critical Army requirements.

Explanation: This action procures low visibility flares for USSOCOM operations. The currently fielded flares that are used during the USSOCOM night flight operations have a significant drawback. The hot gasses from these flares are visible by the naked eye. The low visibility flares are form and fit into the existing dispenser system on all rotary wing aircraft, and in conjunction with infrared (IR) exhaust suppressors, can counter modern, shoulder-fired Infrared weapons.
