This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it exceeds thresholds, involves a new start, and uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007. In addition, this action is pursuant to section 102A (d) (2) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended by the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004. This action realigns \$83.345 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 07/08, appropriation and transfers \$20.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 07/08, appropriation to Other Procurement, Air Force, 07/09, appropriation.

This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has previously been denied by the Congress.
