This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007. This action transfers \$32.149 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 07/08, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 07/07, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress.



Explanation: Additional funds are required to support fully Secretary of Defense and congressionally directed boards, commissions, panels, and task forces to include the recently established President’s Commission on Care for America’s Returning Wounded Warriors and the Independent Review Group on Rehabilitative Care and Administrative Processes at Walter Reed Army Medical Center and the National Naval Medical Center. The WHS also has insufficient resources to finance the needs for the Commission on National Guard and Reserves, the Commission on the Implementation of the New Strategic Posture of the United States, the Commission to assess the threat to the United States from electromagnetic pulse attack, the Defense Business Board, the Defense Task Force on sexual assault in the military, and the quadrennial review of military compensation.
