This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it affects a congressional special interest item. This reprogramming action realigns \$36.0 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 07/08, appropriation for the Future Combat Systems (FCS). This reprogramming action does not use any general transfer authority. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
