
This reprogramming action is submitted for Congressional prior approval because it initiates a new start. This reprogramming action realigns funds within the Procurement of Ammunition, 07/09, Army appropriation and Procurement of Ammunition, Army, 06/08, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and has not been previously denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funds are required to procure the L606 flare (Flare Multispectral, Aircraft Countermeasure) which will be used to protect Army fixed-wing and rotary wing aircraft from infrared guided threats. Once sufficient quantities of the L606 flare are on hand it will replace the M206, M211, and M212 flares. This is a **new start**.

Funds are realigned from the M211 Flare, Infrared Countermeasures, LA14 (\$5.734 million) and the M212 Flare, Infrared Countermeasures, LA15 (\$5.450 million) to fund this higher priority requirement to revise the mix of countermeasure flares in the Army inventory.
