

This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it transfers \$800.0 million from the Iraq Security Forces Fund, 07/08, appropriation to various Defense appropriations pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2007. This action uses \$233.0 million of general transfer authority. Pursuant to section 1302 of Public Law 110-28, U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007, \$567.0 million of the \$800.0 million will not be taken into account for purposes of the limitation on the amount of funds that may be transferred under section 8005. This action restores funding to the programs and appropriations that were used as sources in the Department's reprogramming action FY 07-07-R PA, Iraq Security Forces Funding Acceleration, dated April 3, 2007. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress. **This action replaces reprogramming action FY 07-25 PA, dated June 13, 2007.**
