This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses \$21.9 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 1302 of Public Law 110-28, U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007. Specifically, this action transfers \$21.9 million from the Procurement, Marine Corps, 07/09, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy 07/08, appropriation to finance critical testing for the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) vehicle program. While the Congress provided some testing funding for the MRAP program in Public Law 110-28, some additional funding is needed to address the remaining requirement. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress. This action replaces Reprogramming Action FY 07-20 PA (MRAP), which was sent to Congress on May 14, 2007; the Department is withdrawing FY 07-20 PA.
