This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it realigns funding between budget activities (BAs) in the Joint Improvised Explosive Defeat Fund (JIEDDF), 07/09, appropriation by more than \$20.0 million. In December 2006 the Department began executing FY 2007 Title IX JIEDDF funds totaling \$1,920.7 million according to the management plan presented congressional staffers. In May 2007, as a result of rapidly evolving in-theater conditions that necessitated an emphasis on attacking Improvised Explosive Device (IED) networks, the Department notified the congressional committees of its intent to realign funds between BAs while waiting for the anticipated FY 2007 Supplemental appropriation. Specifically, funds were realigned from BA 2, BA 3, and BA 4 into BA 1. The FY 2007 Supplemental Appropriation (Title I, Chapter 3) provided an additional \$2,432.8 million, bringing the total FY 2007 JIEDFF funding to \$4,353.5 million. With the additional funds, the JIEDFF budget activities require rebalancing for “pay-back” purposes and to focus additional attention on technologies addressing the IED Network and costs associated with training the force.

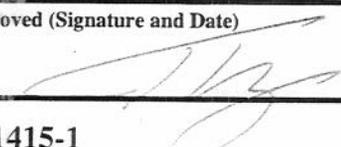

Budget Activity 3: Train the Force

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Explanation: Provides \$150.0 million payback for the May 2007 realignment. An additional \$70.0 million is provided to increase focus on programs aimed at training the force. These include: Home Station Training for the Army and Marine Corps, IED after action reporting video feedback system (formerly L3 Praetorian), Division Counter IED Support Team, and expansion of Explosive Ordnance Disposal Satellite Communications (SATCOM).
