

This transfer is pursuant to authority provided in Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007 and Public Law 110-28, U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act.

Explanation: Provides for continued development and operational assessment of networked, tactical command and control radios with "push-to-talk" using commercially-based, satellite capability. This capability will reduce combat casualties and enhance mission effectiveness for small, dispersed teams operating in remote mountainous regions of Afghanistan. Specifically, this action will procure and deploy twenty prototype radios, with necessary support and training, which will provide small remote teams with beyond-line-of-sight, netted, tactical communications for command and control.
