This reprogramming action transfers \$1,737 million from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) vehicle Fund, 08/08 appropriation to various Defense appropriations to continue the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected Vehicle program execution in FY 2008. This reprogramming action is pursuant to section 8122 of Public Law 110-116, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2008. The MRAP Vehicle program is a critical priority joint-Service program which supports urgent force protection warfighting needs for operating forces in Iraq and Afghanistan.
