This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 110-116, the Department of Defense Appropriations (DoD) Act, 2008; and section 1001 of Public Law 110-181, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2008. This action transfers \$30.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 08/08, appropriation to the Overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid, Defense, 08/10, appropriation. The action uses \$30.0 million of general transfer authority. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements and has not previously been denied by the Congress.
