
This action transfers \$22.8 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 08/09 appropriation. This action does not use general transfer authority. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress. This reprogramming impacts the Military Intelligence Program (MIP). **This action replaces reprogramming action FY 08-41 PA, dated September 24, 2008.**
