This reprogramming action transfers \$1.2 million from the Defense Health Program, Operation and Maintenance, 09/09, appropriation to the Defense Health Program, Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, 09/10, appropriation for proper execution. This reprogramming action uses \$1.2 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 110-329, the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2009; and section 1001 of Public Law 110-417, the Duncan Hunter National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009. These reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
