Pursuant to authorities provided under 10 U.S.C. 2703(e), \$0.509 million was credited to the Environmental Restoration, Navy transfer appropriation as a result of the Teledyne court settlement action administered by the Department of Justice. An additional \$4.016 million was credited to the Environmental Restoration, Navy transfer appropriation as a result of the Fridley court settlement action administered by the Department of Justice.

Part I transfers \$1.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 09/09, appropriation back to the Environmental Restoration, Army appropriation pursuant to the authorities provided under Division C of Public Law 110-329, the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2009.

Part II transfers \$5.525 million from the Environmental Restoration, Army and Environmental Restoration, Navy, appropriations to the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 09/09, appropriation and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 09/10, appropriation for approved environmental restoration activities pursuant to the authorities provided by Division C of Public Law 110-329, the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2009. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703(c), funds transferred from the various Defense Environmental Restoration transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.
