



This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it initiates a **new start** and uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 110-116, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2008; and section 1001 of Public Law 110-181, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal (FY) 2008. This action transfers \$8.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 08/09, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test and Evaluation, Army, 08/09, appropriation. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and has not been denied previously by the Congress.
