This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval since it exceeds established reprogramming thresholds and uses general transfer authority. This reprogramming action transfers \$125.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 10/10, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 10/10, appropriation and realigns \$10.0 million within the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 10/10, appropriation. This reprogramming action uses \$125.0 million in general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 111-118, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2010; and section 1001 of Public Law 111-84, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funding is required for implementation of the Army’s Global Network Enterprise Construct (GNEC) and to fully resource the Army’s Microsoft license agreements. Implementation of standardized Network Operations and Information Assurance is an essential component of the Army’s plan to meet Information Operations Condition Three tasks for network defense as mandated by Joint Task Force – Global Network Operations. The GNEC is needed to improve the Army’s overall information security in an environment of increasing threats to information technology (IT) infrastructure. Funding for the Microsoft license agreements will ensure there is no lapse in Microsoft product support across the Army to maintain the IT systems.
