This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$18.9 million between Army appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$18.9 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 9002 of P.L. 111-118, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriation Act, 2010.

Explanation: Funds are required to support the Tissue Stabilization, Counter Improvised Explosive Device (IED), and Entry Control Point Protection projects. The ongoing Tissue Stabilization efforts require an additional \$11.250 million to ensure transition of the capability from research to Food and Drug Administration approved technology to address critical medical technology gaps. The Counter Improvised Explosive Device (IED) projects require \$7.6 million to support the Remote Weapons System, the Robotic Roller/Rake and Robotic Sensor, the Small Combat Outposts Hasty Counter Suicide Vehicle Borne Improvised Explosive Devices (SVBIEDs) which includes the Rapid Camera System used to defeat SVBIEDS, the Electronic Unmanned Ground Sensors, and the Small Projected Line Charge Light. The Entry Control Point Protection project requires \$0.075 million to support the Pop-Up Barriers effort. This is a congressional special interest item. This is Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) funding.
