This reprogramming action realigns \$7.6 million within the Other Procurement, Air Force, 11/13, appropriation for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress. These funds were appropriated in Title IX of Division A of Public Law 112-10, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2011.
