This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because this action exceeds established reprogramming thresholds, and initiates a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$80.0 million within the Missile Procurement, Air Force, 10/12, appropriation.

GPSIII – Space Segment Advanced Procurement (CY)	-	80,000

Explanation: Funds are required to begin advanced procurement for Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) IIIA long-lead items for production vehicles 3-4. The current negotiated contract contains a long lead option. If the production contract is not awarded by December 23, 2010, a one year slip in satellite delivery could occur, due to contract renegotiation, thus impacting worldwide coverage. This is a **new start**.
